Eligibility requirements:

- High school seniors of Greek descent accepted to an accredited college or university
- And one of the following:
 - Resident of the greater Norwalk area
 - Member of St. George Greek Orthodox Church of Norwalk, CT
 - Member of Pontian Society "PONTOS" of Norwalk, CT

Scholarship will be awarded to two (2) successful applicants in the amount of **\$2,000.00** each. The scholarship will be presented directly to the recipient. This is a one-time scholarship.

Deadline: Completed application must be received on or before **September 30th.**

Winners will be notified by mail by the end of **October 2022.**

Official announcement of winner and presentation will be made at the Annual Dance of the Pontian Society, "PONTOS" of Norwalk in November.

 - c. or Member of St. George Greek Orthodox Church Norwalk, CT
4. Provide copies of SAT scores and high school transcripts
5. Extracurricular activities and community involvement
6. Participation in church-related activities
7. Essay
Please write on the following topic for your essay:

- ***Choose a landmark in Asia Minor – Pontos and write about its cultural significance and link it to its current state.***

Essay may be written in English or Greek. Essay must be at least 1,000 words or more in length, type-written and double-spaced.

All applicant names and essays will remain anonymous to scholarship committee until after winner is selected. All information requested on the application must be completed and will be confidential.

DEADLINE: All applications must be postmarked on or before **September 30, 2022**. Applications postmarked after **September 30, 2022**, will not be accepted.
